Educational Systems Planning is providing technology planning and communications infrastructure design for the Catto Community School under a contract with Hillier Architecture. The SCC demonstration project with by Camden School District and the City of Camden is for a 113,498 square-foot pre-Kindergarten through 6th grade facility for approximately 500 students. It will replace the existing Catto Elementary and Davis Elementary Schools to provide more capacity for academic and athletic activities.

The nonprofit Boys and Girls Club of Camden County will finance and operate a new facility attached to Catto School that will feature a 7,000-square-foot swimming pool and community meeting rooms. Students can use these facilities and the swimming pool during school hours, and Boys and Girls Club members can use school common areas, such as the gym and auditorium during non-school hours.

The voice, video data and security systems will include a single building-wide communications infrastructure with each occupant (school/boys & girls club) having separate telephone, intercom, internet service providers with a single zoned security system. ESP has an expanded scope of work for this project which includes full responsibility for E-rate process, specification of all network electronics, and file servers and computers.

The school was officially turned over for occupation in September 2007.
