Educational Systems Planning is currently assisting the Waldon Studio Architects develop a 10 year campus-wide Facilities Master Plan for the expansion of the seminary to an undergraduate and graduate educational facility. ESP is developing an Educational Program Vision statement that provide information on: (1) current and future programs for both the college and seminary, (2) anticipated/desired enrollment estimates, (3) faculty resource requirements to support versioned growth, and (4) an indication of the number and type of buildings required to support growth in students and faculty.

ESP will develop a list of recommended buildings necessary to allow the college/seminary to accomplish its growth in enrollment and program. The listing will provide the following information:

- Number and type of new buildings required
- Program functionality of each new building
- Approximate size of each new building
- Recommended additions to existing buildings

At the completion of tasks 1 and 2, ESP staff will participate in meetings with Waldon Studio to develop alternative site plans which incorporate the new and modified buildings into the master site plan.
