The first task involved the Charette process with the Headmasters Advisory Group to focus on desired learning environments, teaching and learning trends, desired integration of technology and the impact on school design. The second task involved the development of the Technology Utilization and Infrastructure Plan Document which provided the architect with a “basis of design” for the instructional components of the school.
