Libraries and Community Centers

Innovative Systems Design and Training, dba Educational Systems Planning has provided IT/AV/ Security systems design for a number of public libraries and over 30 high school media centers. The most recent public libraries are the Palisades and Capital View Libraries in the District of Columbia. Palisades Library was a \$7,500,000 project consisted of 30,000 sf renovation/addition and opened in 2017. Capital View Library is also a renovation/addition, similar in size, with an estimated cost of \$7,900,000 and is currently in construction. ESP is currently providing technology design for the addition to the Kent Island Library. ESP designed the voice, video, data and security systems for the 21,000 SF new Colmore Manor (MD) Community Center. The \$ 5 million building contains the mayor's office, police station with holding cell, town administrative offices, a gymnasium, and community meeting rooms. The multi-purpose meeting room has an auxiliary sound system and AV projection system to support large group presentations.

Recreation Facilities

ESP recently completed technology planning and design for three recreation centers in the District of Columbia. The plan for the Kenilworth Recreation Center is to modernize a portion of Kenilworth Elementary School plus the addition of a gym and outdoor swimming pool. The second project is the design of the new 15,000 SF Marvin Gaye Recreation Center on the site of the existing center. The third facility is the renovation and expansion of the 56,000 SF Southeast Tennis and Learning Center. ESP's responsibilities for these projects include the design of voice, video, data and security systems, as well as, acoustical consulting for the new Marvin Gaye Center. The firm is currently providing similar services for the design of the Bowie, Maryland Ice Rink.



Homeless Shelters

ESP recently provided IT and security systems design for the District of Columbia owned "La Casa" supportive housing project. The seven floor 26,500 SF building includes single efficiency units, a community room and exterior courtyard for tenants. The firm is currently providing similar design services for Emergency Family Shelters in Wards 3,5,and 6.



Office Building Fit-outs

ESP recently developed bid documents for the seven story 70,000 SF central office fit-out of leased space for the Alexandria City Public Schools. The firms responsibilities included design of; (1) video distribution , (2) structured voice cabling, (3) structured data cabling, and (4) video surveillance and access control systems. The fast track project opened in June 2016. In addition the firm provided similar design services for 80,000 sf of leased office space for the Arlington County Public Schools and recently completed design for secure renovation of the DC Office of Human Rights.
