Educational Systems Planning (ESP) provided IT services for the new Patterson-Claremont School. The new replacement school was built on the existing site adjacent to the current building. The project consists of a 9th–12th grade high school, a career and technology program, and the Claremont special education facility. The project will be approximately 267,771 gross square feet and cost about \$65 million to complete. The high school serves 1,450 students and opened in 2019.

ESP delivered IT/AV/Security consulting services for the project. ESP's work included designs for intercom, intrusion detection, physical access control, and CCTV surveillance systems. These systems provide Baltimore City students with the safe environment to acquire an excellent education and the skills to thrive in the adult world.
